

January 2015 Licensure Updates through 01/15/2015:

CO – Durable Medical Equipment Supplier License – (Updated note A to show the new DME license requirement applies to contract suppliers only that provide DME and supplies as part of the Medicare Competitive Bidding Program)

CO – Added Note B - The CO Secretary of State's office will issue one Durable Medical Equipment Supplier license per supplier. One license will cover the multiple locations of the supplier as long as the license is displayed at each of their physical locations.

OH – Note G – (Updated Note G to add Pharmacists to the list of licensed healthcare professionals exempt from Chapter 4779 (Orthotics, Prosthetics, & Pedorthics licensing) when practicing within the individual's scope of practice)

IA – Note B – The Iowa Board of Podiatry established the rules to license Orthotists, Prosthetists, and Pedorthists. The licenses are not required of health care practitioners licensed in this state such as physicians, registered nurses, physical therapists, occupational therapists, chiropractors, and pharmacists who engage in the profession or occupation for which they are licensed.
