Blood Glucose Monitors/Supplies (Mail Order) requires the Durable Medical Equipment Supplier License.

New Note D:

If a company is delivering oxygen tanks to a beneficiary, then a State of Hawaii Pharmacy License (or Pharmacy Miscellaneous Permit if out of state) is required

New Note E:

Oxygen concentrators and nebulizers may be dispensed with only the Hawaii Durable Medical Equipment Supplier License, in lieu of a pharmacy license.

Arizona

The Dispensing Optician License no longer required for Ocular Prostheses.

Kentucky - New Note

Note G:

Oxygen concentrators may be dispensed with only the Home Medical Equipment licensure.
