

## June Updates

### **AR –**

The Respiratory Therapist license requirement was deleted from respiratory equipment codes. (R01 Continuous Positive Airway Pressure (CPAP Devices); R02 High Frequency Chest Wall Oscillation Devices/Supplies; R03 Invasive Mechanical Ventilation Devices; R04 Intermittent Positive Pressure Breathing (IPPB Devices); R05 Intrapulmonary Percussive Ventilation Devices; R06 Mechanical In Exsufflation Devices; R07 Nebulizer Equipment and/or Supplies; R12 Ventilators Accessories and/or Supplies; R09 Respiratory Assist Devices; R10 Respiratory Suction Pumps; R08 Oxygen Equipment and/or Supplies)

### Deleted Note F

(A Respiratory Therapist or another authorized practitioner licensed in Arkansas such as a physician, advanced practice nurse or pharmacist is required for respiratory equipment set-up, administration and education. A supplier may contract with an Arkansas qualified individual to provide this service to the patient. Non-licensed personnel may only deliver respiratory equipment for use by a patient.)

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### **ID**

Added Note C to Prosthetic Lenses: Conventional Eyeglasses (PD11); Prosthetic Lenses: Conventional Contact Lenses (PD12); Prosthetic Lenses: Prosthetic Cataract Lenses (PD13)

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### **KY**

Note B was updated to outline Kentucky's new HME licensure requirement: Effective June 24, 2015, KY will only grant a home medical equipment provider that is located in one of Kentucky's seven contiguous states that license home medical equipment providers.

Note C was updated to outline exemptions to Kentucky's new HME licensure requirements.

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### **VA**

Note D regarding Sanitizer Permit was updated to add: VA law allows for companies to sanitize items at a single licensed location and transport items to branch locations. Thus a Sanitizer Permit is only required at the location where sanitation takes place.

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
