



Encounter Data Processing System General Updates

- The **EDS Incident Tracking Tool** was posted on 04/12/12 for MAOs to provide input on incidents related to EDS reports. Eighteen (18) incidents were submitted and 80% of the comments were regarding the delay of MAO-002 report receipt. As of 4/16/2012, the outstanding reports have been processed and distributed to MAOs and other entities.



MAO-002 Reports

- Some MAO-002 reports have been sent with the incorrect report names. The prefix was transposed in the Gentran mailbox and reads "T.XXXXX.EPDS_" rather than "EDPS". MAOs and other entities are advised to search for the reports under "EPDS" Gentran mailbox. The issue was corrected on 4/16/2012. All reports loaded on 4/16/2012 and forward will have the correct naming convention.
- All of the issues identified with edits have been resolved.



End-To-End Testing

Every week, the EDPS bulletin will provide the results of MAO-002 reports analysis with top errors and any notable findings. For the week of April 10, MAO-002 reports reflected the following errors:

- 98325 Claim is an Exact Duplicate of a Previously Priced Claim
- 02240 Beneficiary Not Enrolled in Medicare Advantage Organization for Date of Service
- 02110 Beneficiary Health Insurance Carrier Number (HICN) Not on File
- 02125 Beneficiary Date of Birth Mismatch
