Payment Confirmation

- Payment Confirmation Report is built using information found on the Manufacturer Invoice Report
- Manufacturer creates the report and sends to the TPA
- Confirmations are made at the contract level

Payment Confirmation Response File Types

- Accepted
 - Payments match invoiced amounts

- Rejected
 - o File or data errors

- Discrepant
 - Amount confirmed does not match amount invoiced

1099s

- At manufacturers' request, CMS consulted with the IRS to determine if manufacturers must send 1099s to Part D sponsors for CGDP discounts the manufacturer pays to Part D sponsors.
- The IRS may provide guidance on this issue in a "private letter ruling" issued to an individual taxpayer in response to a written request. Manufacturers may consider requesting a private letter ruling.

1099s (cont.)

- The process for requesting a private letter ruling and the required user fee are described in Revenue Procedure 2011-1. Tax professionals are familiar with this procedure.
- http://www.irs.gov/pub/irs-irbs/irb11-01.pdf
- The IRS releases "private letter rulings" to the public in redacted form after deleting private information.
- CMS advises manufacturers to consult their tax professional to assist in submitting their questions in writing to the IRS.

340(b)

- Implemented by the Veterans Health Care Act of 1992
- Amended the Public Health Service Act added § 340B
- Limits costs of outpatient prescription drugs
- Limited to certain health care organizations (340b entities) statutorily defined
- Prescription drug claims from 340b entities:
 - NOT eligible for manufacturer MEDICAID rebates
 - ELIGIBLE for the MEDICARE Coverage Gap Discount


Disputes and Appeals

- Manufacturer must first submit disputes to the TPA.
- Manufacturers may appeal TPA decision
 - Within 30 days of receiving the TPA decision or
 - 60 days after filing the dispute with the TPA, if no decision has been reached. Whichever date is EARLIER.
- Provider Resources, Inc. (IRE) must provide a decision within 90 days of receiving an appeal.
- Manufacturers may appeal IRE decision to the CMS Administrator.

IRE Operations

- IRE operates independently with CMS general oversight.
- Appeals must be submitted via the IRE's portal.
- A link to the portal will be posted on the CMS Manufacturer's web page beginning July 18th at the following address: http://www.cms.gov/PrescriptionDrugCovGenIn/05 Pharma.asp.
- Only information submitted with dispute, or in response to a specific request from the IRE will be considered.
- Manufacturers should review May 31, 2011, Discount Program Guidance prior to submitting an appeal.
