



MAO-002 Reports – Known Issues

Below are errors generated on MAO-002 Encounter Data Processing Status Reports that are being investigated by analysts for enhancements to the EDPS.

- **Error Code 17295 – Inpatient Claim Missing Revenue Code or Outpatient Claim Missing Either Revenue Code or HCPCS Code**
 - This error code is intended to process roster bills, which do not apply to EDS. This edit will be deactivated in the near future.
- **Error Code 03102 – Provider Type or Specialty Not Allowed to Bill for Procedure**
 - This error code is currently generated on MAO-002 Encounter Data Processing Status Reports as an “informational” error. The status will be adjusted to indicate “reject”.
- **Error Code 98325 – Exact Duplicate of a Service Line within this Claim or a Previously Priced Claim**
 - This error code is currently generated on MAO-002 Encounter Data Processing Status Reports as a “reject” error at the encounter header level instead of the line level for Inpatient encounters. The system shall also consider the procedure code along with the revenue code in the duplicate verification logic for Inpatient encounters.



Timely Filing Guidelines

SUBMISSION TYPE	TIMELY FILING DEADLINE
Full Encounter	13 months from DOS
Correct/Replace or Void/Delete Encounter	13 months from DOS not to exceed 30 days from adjudication date of adjusted claim <ul style="list-style-type: none">• When an MAO or other entity receives an adjustment to an original claim, the adjusted encounter must be submitted to EDS within 30 days of the adjudication
Chart Review Encounter	Within 25 months of the data collection period



Tier 2 Testing

MAOs and other entities are encouraged to submit encounter data for Tier 2 Testing in order to ensure accurate programming and submission of encounters.



Important Reminder

All 2012 DOS Home Health, Skilled Nursing Facility (SNF), Hospice, Critical Access Hospitals (CAH), and Swing Bed encounters should be excluded from submission until further guidance is provided.
