Dear Administrator:

The Maryland General Assembly recently passed Senate Bill 108, which the Governor has signed into law. This new law authorizes the Secretary of Health to eliminate license renewal requirements and licensing fees. Thus, beginning on July 1, 2018, the effective date of this new law, you are no longer required to submit a license renewal application or submit a licensing fee. This letter is to confirm that the non-expiring Residential Service Agency license, which was previously sent, authorizes your agency to operate the branch location at:

Although there are no longer any license renewal requirements, you are still required to comply with all statutory and regulatory requirements, and are subject to discipline, including license revocation, for any violations of these requirements.
